- 3) **The use of “unknown tongues,” that are ecstatic, unintelligible utterances used in some nominal churches, are considered as being from whom? What would be their purpose?** *Q768*

- 4) **How does Paul compare “speaking in tongues” to “prophesying”?** *1 Cor. 14:22,23; 1 Cor. 14:31,39; 1 Cor. 12:31*

- 5) **How are we to edify one another and why is this important?** *Eph. 4:2-6,11,12,15,16; 1 Thess.5:11,14; Rom. 14:19; 1 John 3:18; Acts 20:35; Col. 3:23*
