- 1) **Name just one witness of being “drawn to Christ.” How were you drawn to Christ? What did you have to admit or what realization came to you as you were drawn? Where was faith in all of this?** *Heb. 10:19,22; Heb. 11:6; I Cor. 1:30*

- 2) **What did you consider and what did you surrender to God when you made your consecration? And for how long? Based on 1 and 2 considerations and confessions, what can you conclude?** *Luke 14:28; Rev. 2:10; Matt. 10:37,38*

- 3) **What evidence or evidences do you have to this day—that the Lord is working with you and your consecration is still valid? What should you expect to see or experience as a child of God who has consecrated?** *John 15:2,5; 1 Pet. 1:7; Heb. 12:6 9-11; Heb. 11:1*

- 4) **What if you have doubts about your consecration? Where might that come from? What if your failings and mistakes, sins, etc. overwhelm you in discouragement. What should you ask or do?** *Ps. 51:17; 1 Pet. 5:7-9; 1 Pet. 3:12; 1 John 1:9; 1 John 2:1, Phil. 1:6, Heb. 4:16*

- 5) **Is it possible for any who have consecrated to be “cut off” as “branches from the true vine”? Under what conditions do you think that could happen? How can you make sure that does not happen?** *John 15:2; Hebr. 10:38; 1 John 3:9; Heb. 6:4-6; John 15:7; 2 Tim. 2:15; Heb. 2:14-15*
