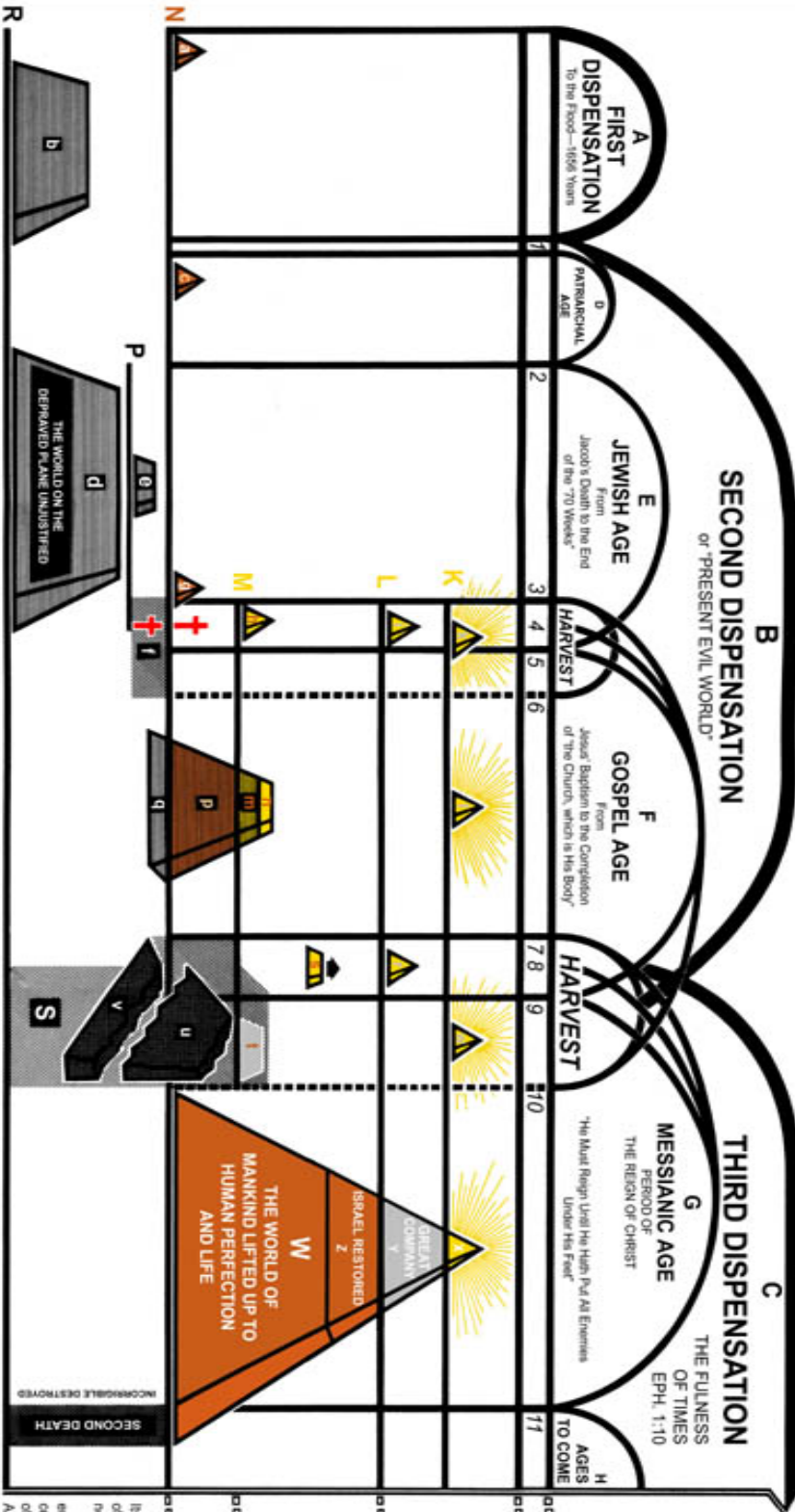

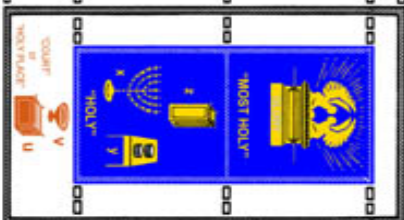

THE TABERNACLE OF THE WILDERNESS

The Harmony of its Teachings



Its teachings are in harmony with the Chart of the Ages, showing the same Steps as necessary in coming from sin to glory. The entire ground of the Tabernacle enclosure was called "Holy." Outside the court all was unholy, and is the equivalent of the unjustified plane in Chart of the Ages. The Court enclosure parallels the justified or Perfect Human plane. The "Holy" represents the condition of consecrated Christians, begotten of the Spirit. The Most Holy, beyond the second veil, represents the Perfect Spiritual condition when "we shall be like Him." The glory plane is still further along the grand climax of hope—"Glory, Honor and Immortality."
